Second Jubilee project at Bulembu Church of the Nazarene – The second Jubilee offering church in Bulembu is complete! The church has been meeting in the sanctuary for the last three weeks and will have revival this coming week. On Sunday, November 28th Andy and Amy Curry attended church there. Each week the congregation is slowly growing, this week having 42 people. The Curry's were overwhelmed with God's love as they listened to the gift of church members singing in their new church structure as they remembered that two months ago the church had block walls that were falling down.
