

**Day 8.** Pray for the orphans in Swaziland as their numbers are expected to rise to 200,000 by 2012. Pray for those caring for these orphans, such as New Hope Centre and Gigi's Place.

**Day 9.** Pray for the 500,000 in Swaziland living without access to clean drinking water and the continued development of clean waters systems throughout the country.

**Day 10.** Pray for all the leaders of the Swaziland Partnership as they provide leadership and vision.

**Day 11.** Pray that the Swaziland Partnership will have favor in the eyes of all government officials involved both in Swaziland and in America where international affairs must be approved.

**Day 12.** Pray for Sub-Saharan Africa who has only 10% of the world's population, but 70% of the world's AIDS patients.

**Day 13.** Pray for traveling mercies, protection, health and unity of the Global Outreach teams. These are teams of lay people who have a heart for making a difference on a 10-12 day mission trip.

**Day 14.** Pray for our on-site coordinators, Evan and Andrea Mosshart, who are the liaison between the Partnership and the work in Swaziland.

**Day 15.** Pray for the use of the JESUS film and the new Swazi Christians who have made a commitment to follow Christ. Pray for the local churches as they disciple new believers.

## THE SWAZILAND PARTNERSHIP

HIV/AIDS is the greatest humanitarian crisis in the history of the world. AIDS has killed more people than all the famines, floods, natural disasters, and wars in history—and there is no end in sight.

Swaziland has the highest rate of HIV/AIDS in the world

- It is estimated that 42% of the population is infected.
- One out of five children in Swaziland in an orphan.
- A 15 year old has only a 20% chance of reaching 35.
- 15,000 households are headed by orphaned children.

## OUR GOAL

We are working to reduce the HIV/AIDS rate in Swaziland in the next ten years through key spiritual, medical, compassionate, and educational resources.

The Swaziland Partnership is a cooperative effort between the Swaziland Church of the Nazarene, Swaziland Nazarene Health Institutions, Nazarene Compassionate Ministries Africa, Nazarene Compassionate Ministries, Inc., Bethany First Church of the Nazarene, and Southern Nazarene University.

**Day 18.** Pray for the College of Nursing as they train nurses that will be filled with knowledge and compassion for their patients.

**Day 19.** Pray for the College of Theology as they raise up future pastors for Swaziland.

**Day 20.** Pray for the Teacher Training College as they provide future educational leaders for Swaziland.

**Day 21.** Pray for Barbi Moore, Director of Global Outreach, her assistant Pat Burton, and the Swazi Leadership Council as they work alongside the Swazi National Board on our partnership plan.

**Day 22.** Pray for a medical breakthrough in HIV/AIDS research.

**Day 23.** Pray for the leaders of the HIV/AIDS Task Force as go into homes and minister daily to those affected by AIDS and other opportunistic infections.
