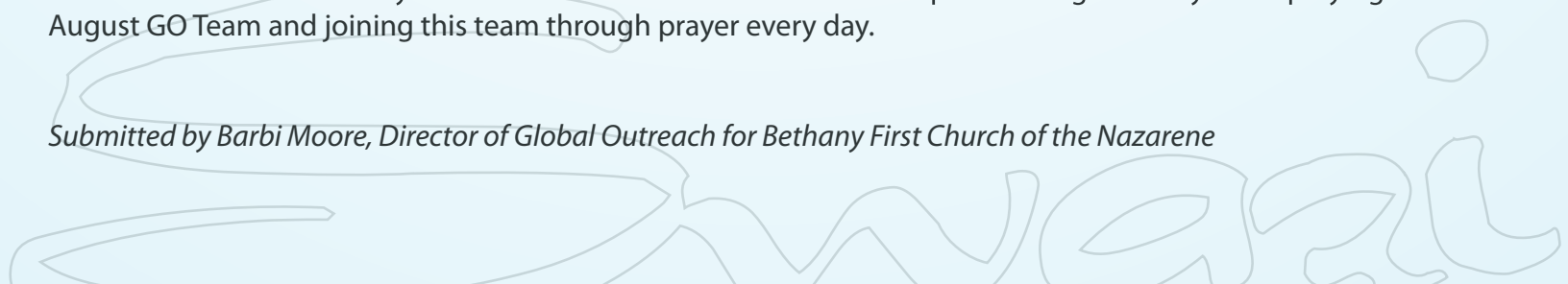

- **Swazi Nazarene Pastoral Couples and Single Pastors Conference** – August 16-19, 2011
The Swazi Nazarene district superintendents are hosting a conference on equipping their pastors and spouses in how to speak to their congregations about AIDS. Bethany First Church has been a partner in the planning and will assist during the conference. Please be praying for Dr. David Busic as the keynote speaker. Also remember Dr. James Copple, Dr. Fili Chambo, Rev. Cosmos Mutowa, and Dr. Nkosingiphile Kunene as they speak in the plenary sessions and Rev. Collin Elliott, Rev. Michael LaVigne, Ellyn Marsh, and Rev. Cariot and Evelyn Shongwe as workshop leaders. Dr. Paul Rothwell and The Luke Commission will offer complimentary health evaluations for all in attendance. - **Ntondozi Child Development Centre** – The GO Team will all have the opportunity to visit our new Child Development Centre at Ntondozi Church of the Nazarene. Our construction team will help build a new cooking area for the Child Development Centre and will evaluate the water situation surrounding the new garden. Our compassion team will provide a Vacation Bible School and will spend time with the children and the volunteers from this new Child Development Centre.
- **Celebrate Recovery in Swaziland** – Ellyn Marsh, licensed family counselor, will provide training to the HIV/AIDS Task Force leaders in the use of a 12-step recovery program for their support groups.
- **HIV/AIDS Task Force** – The entire GO Team will spend a day with the Task Force and will visit homes where the Task Force ministers to those dying of AIDS. The team will be prepared to provide a Gift Bucket for every home filled with needed food and supplies.
