Evan and Andrea Mosshart are doing an outstanding job representing Bethany First in Swaziland. Andrea is being asked to preach in churches and schools and Evan is being sought out by many for his computer expertise. Please continue to pray for health, safety, wisdom, and favor for Evan and Andrea. Here is a sampling of some of the projects they are currently working on with some of our Swazi partners:

- a. Gerald Gassett Memorial Dental Clinic – The Mossharts continue to interface with Raleigh Fitkin Memorial Hospital (RFM) about the upcoming renovation of a building on the RFM campus for this new dental clinic.
- b. Ntondozi Child Development Centre – Evan and a team of men from Ntondozi just finished a building that will be a church office, storage for food, and a kitchen so they can cook a daily meal for the 55 children at our first Child Development Centre.
- c. Our next Jubilee Sanctuary Project – Our next Jubilee sanctuary project will be at Siteki English Church. We are projecting that the July 2012 GO Team will help complete this new sanctuary.
- d. Water for the Ntondozi Garden – The March 2012 GO Team will help provide a water well for the garden at Ntondozi.
- e. Terracing and drainage at the Nkiliji Garden – Our first sponsored garden in the community of Nkiliji has difficulties with water drainage since the land is on the side of a hill. We have some landscapers going with the March 2012 GO Team that will work on the terracing and drainage of this land.

Thank you for your prayers for Swaziland as we believe in a great God who calls us to pray for others.
