Gerald Gassett Memorial Dental Clinic – Dr. Tim Rothwell, DDS, is working on the donation of a dental clinic in Swaziland. This would be the first public dental clinic in Swaziland. We are getting ready to ship our next container to Swaziland filled with medical equipment, supplies, and all that is needed to install the dental clinic. Renovation of the space that will house this clinic, at Raleigh Fitkin Memorial Hospital in Manzini, will begin after the first of the year. The July 2012 GO Team will help install the equipment and dedicate this first public dental clinic in Swaziland. God bless Gerald's memory as many will be helped through this clinic.

Siteki Farm at the Nazarene College of Theology – Bill Dillard is currently working with the new Nazarene University in Swaziland on their idea of a farm at the College of Theology. Current ideas for the farm include land for vegetable and fruit farming, cattle, beekeeping, and tilapia. Bill will be returning to Swaziland in March 2012, with some beekeeping experts, as the planning continues. The proceeds from this farm will provide scholarships for the College of Theology. All students will have an opportunity to work on the farm to learn skills in all these areas. Once they graduate, they will receive seedlings, fingerlings, and a queen bee, along with some equipment to start their own community garden at their new church assignment. This is a praise and a prayer request for God's continued wisdom and direction.
