**New Jubilee Church in Sicagweni** – The 2009 BFC Centennial Celebration Jubilee offering continues to help others with new sanctuaries in Swaziland. The Sicagweni Church of the Nazarene has been building a new sanctuary for the past 20 years! With funds from the Jubilee offering, BFC we will be able to help with their roof, doors, and windows. The Sicagweni Church has enough funds to provide the final plaster and paint to complete their new sanctuary. This is our fifth church to assist in Swaziland as we partner with a local congregation in the completion of their sanctuary.

**Newer car for Swaziland** – We have needed a newer car for Swaziland and were having difficulty in locating a good used 4-wheel drive vehicle without a lot of miles in Swaziland. Onsite coordinators Evan and Andrea Mosshart, with the help of David Cooper in the regional office in Johannesburg, were able to locate a good used vehicle in South Africa. We pray this will help our onsite coordinators for years to come with a solid and reliable vehicle.

### PRAYER CONCERNS:

**Assessment trip** – Barbi Moore, Director of Global Outreach, will be returning to Swaziland with Evan and Andrea Mosshart this month. The purpose of her trip is to meet with regional leaders in Johannesburg and with Swazi leaders to review the past four years and to strategize steps for our future partnership.

**Gerald Gassett Memorial Dental Clinic** and the next container shipment – BFC is working with Nazarene Compassionate Ministries and Project C.U.R.E. to ship our next 40' container to Swaziland. All the dental equipment for the new Gerald Gassett Memorial Dental Clinic will be on this container that is due to be shipped in February. The July 2012 GO Team will help install the equipment and dedicate this new clinic. Dr. Tim Rothwell, D.D.S., and Fred and Kathy Evans are giving a lot of leadership to this clinic and the preparation for this next container shipment.

**Raleigh Fitkin Memorial Hospital** – Raleigh Fitkin Memorial Hospital (RFM) is providing a building on their campus for the new Gerald Gassett Memorial Dental Clinic, the first public dental clinic in Swaziland. There is much to do in preparation for this clinic – the approval of the building renovation by the Manzini City Council, the actual renovation of the space, and the installation of equipment in July. RFM has committed to hire a dentist and staff for the ongoing operation of the clinic. Please pray for all that needs to happen in the preparation of this clinic and that it will be a blessing to many.

**GO Teams in March and July** – There are two teams preparing to go and serve in Swaziland in 2012. A team of 28 are preparing to serve in March. Registrations are still open for the July 2012 team. Please pray for these teams and how you can be a part.
